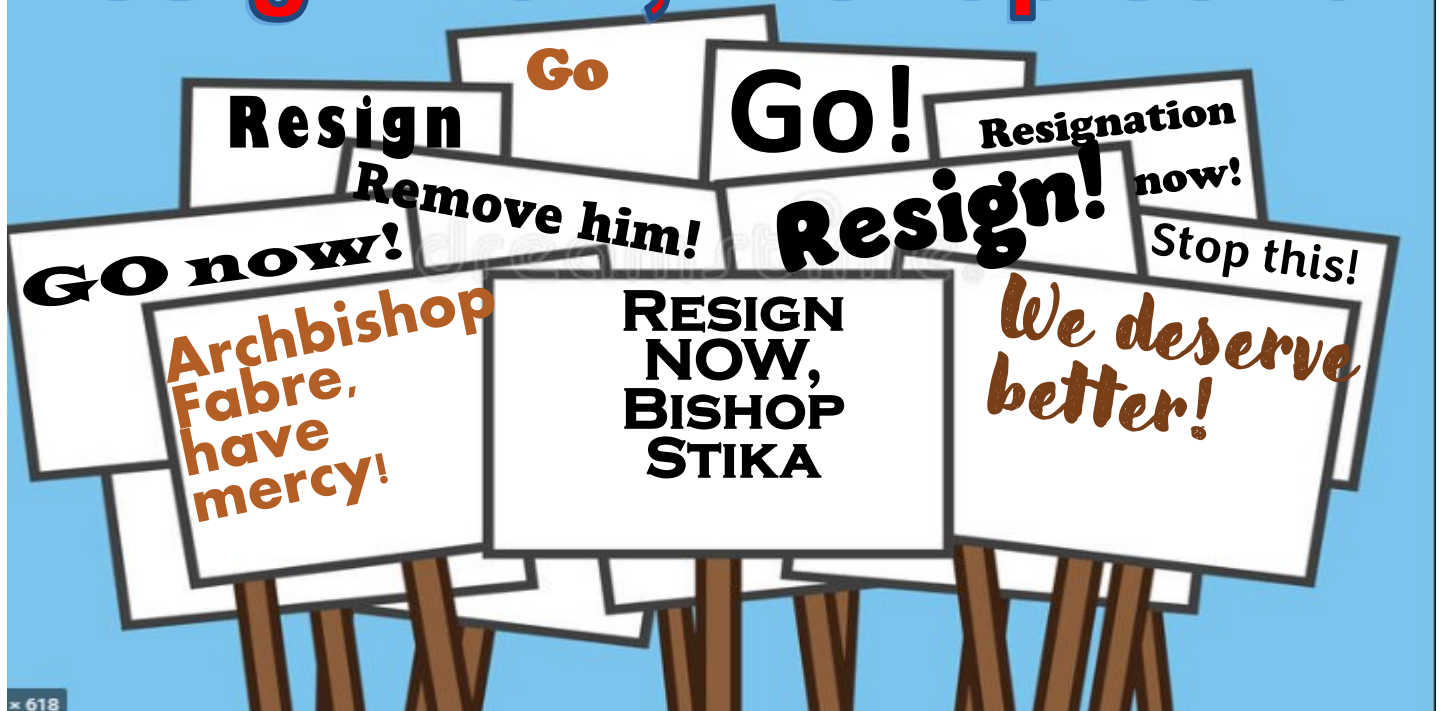


Resign Now, Bishop Stika!



November 27th—Resign now demonstration

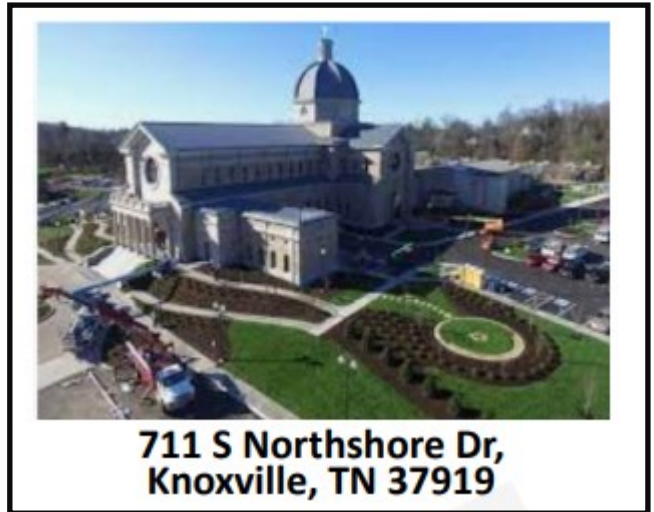
No more intimidation! No more retaliation! Enough is enough! Bishop Stika must go!

Dust off your signs from the last demonstration and bring them to the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on 711 S. Northshore Drive. We will be holding signs at a demonstration 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Sunday, November 27th to once again demand the resignation or removal of Bishop Richard Stika from leadership of the Diocese of Knoxville.

We will be on public property in front of the cathedral and very close to Northshore Drive. I will notify the events coordinator that our presence will be peaceful.

See you there. Dress warmly. Ponchos will be provided in case of rain. We have lots of signs or you can bring your own. (All respectful, please.)

We invite all members of the community no matter what faith or no faith at all. We will be inclusive of the LGBTQ+ community as well as all others. The Latinx community will want to be there for Jane Doe of Gatlinburg and show her our support. Join this cross-section of humanity and stand for the end of intimidation and retaliation. All of these diverse communities will show how many people feel the need for Stika to go.
