### Third deception of the diocese Assignments of Paul F. Haas

Haas molested teen boys. He was assigned to FOUR high schools during his priesthood. At which point in his nearly 2 decades of assignments in high schools did the Nashville diocese know he molested teens?

Paul Frederick Haas. Born Dec. 14, 1933; ordained May 23, 1959; dismissed from the priesthood of the Diocese of Nashville May 24, 1977; died June 7, 1979.

His assignments included: Assistant Pastor of the Cathedral of the Incarnation; Assistant Pastor of St. Ann Church in Nashville and teaching at Father Ryan High School; Assistant Pastor of St. John Church in Memphis and teacher at Memphis Catholic High School for Boys; Assistant Pastor of Sacred Heart Church in Memphis. In addition to assignments in diocesan records, he is also known to have served at St. Jude Church and Notre Dame High School in Chattanooga and in the Diocese of Little Rock, Arkansas, and the Diocese of Owensboro, Kentucky.

Note the vague language about Little Rock and Owensboro in the diocesan statement above.

It is approximately a 33 minute drive from Immaculate Conception Church in Hawesville, KY to Owensboro Catholic High School where Haas taught.

David Brown has a letter from the Bishop of Owensboro confirming that Haas taught at OCHS from 1967 to 1977. Why did Nashville bury this information?

The 1966 entry above suggests the diocese gave him a "hiding out" year after they knew of his rapes. Therefore, the diocese of Nashville engaged in interstate trafficking of pedophiles. Both Arkansas and Kentucky were given a pedophile from Nashville. It is time for the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation to step in and examine all the Nashville files, including secret files? Must also examine the dioceses of Knoxville and Memphis as well.
